Readings for 3 September

Jeremiah 15: 15-21

LORD, you understand; remember me and care for me. Avenge me on my persecutors.

You are long-suffering – do not take me away; think of how I suffer reproach for your sake.

When your words came, I ate them; they were my joy and my heart's delight, for I bear your name, LORD God Almighty.

¹⁷ I never sat in the company of revellers, never made merry with them;

I sat alone because your hand was on me and you had filled me with indignation.

Why is my pain unending and my wound grievous and incurable?

You are to me like a deceptive brook, like a spring that fails.

From that time on Jesus began to explain to his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life.

²² Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. 'Never, Lord!' he said. 'This shall never happen to you!' ²³ Jesus turned and said to Peter, 'Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling-block to me; you do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns.'
